



Supply Chain Coordinator

You will be reporting to Logistics Manager Signe Andrés.

Your main tasks will be:

- Day-to-day coordination of transportation and warehousing of all products, both in the current pre-commercial supply chain and the future commercial supply chain
- Booking and monitoring transports or warehousing services
- Monitoring stock
- Coordinating the provision of necessary documentation and resolving any arising problems or complaints with internal stakeholders and the relevant third party providers.
- Ensuring that transportation and storage is in compliance with customs requirements, GDP requirements, and other laws and regulations

- Maintain plans for transportation and warehouse needs in the pre-commercial supply chain.
- Participating in keeping procedures and tools updated
- Participating in the implementation of relevant IT support systems
- Keep track of quality, quantity, stock levels, delivery times, transport costs, and efficiency
- Maintaining metrics and analysing data to assess performance and implementation improvements
- Handling and coordinating Controlled Drug Licenses
- Intrastat reporting

You must have at least 5 – 10 years of experience from the pharma industry with supply chain, shipping, and logistics, maybe from a similar position. Furthermore, experience with international shipping and experience with cold chain logistics is a must. Experience with shipping to the US, would be an advantage. You should also be familiar with drafting procedures and guidelines. Experience with shipping validation would be an interesting add on, as is knowledge of customs and regulations.

You are educated within transportation or shipping and maybe have a degree in Logistics or Supply Chain. You are proficient in English at a professional level, both written and spoken. You have excellent Excel skills(MS office) and are used to working in ERP systems.

You are a person with a can do attitude. You want to get things done and you want to be part of a team of helpful, service minded people.
